## WHAT'S UP WITH DISC GOLF IN PIONEER PARK

- The new Master Plan for Pioneer Park approved by the Billings City Council includes disc golf.
- The Billings Parks and Recreation Department and Air Fairways are working together to implement this plan as soon as possible which calls for:

### TWO SEASONAL 9 HOLE COURSES

#### South Course

(winter play, 12/1 thru 4/30 annually)  
single basket placements with movable tees

#### North Course

(summer play, 5/1 thru 11/31 annually)  
Multiple basket placements with permanent solid surface tee pad(s)

- Current course will to be removed and rehabilitated to make room for the new summer course.
- The Winter Course (south) will be open to play early this year to allow removal/rehabilitation of current course as well as construction of the new Summer (north) course
- As play begins in a new area of the park it will be CRUCIAL that all rules are followed to continue use of the new area of the park.
